Upper Division, Level-300 Coursework Equivalencies

LITPA-300: Literature & Performing Arts	Two (2) courses in Literature or Performing Arts (nonstudio) (in addition to that satisfying LITPA-200).
SSHIS-300: Social Science / History	Two (2) courses in Social Science or History (in addition to that satisfying SSHIS-200).
PHCRT-300: Philosophy / Critical Theory	Two (2) courses in Philosophy or Critical Theory (in addition to that satisfying PHCRT-200).
SCIMA-300: Science/Mathematics	Two (2) courses in Science or Mathematics (in addition to that satisfying SCIMA-200).
VISST-300: Visual Studies	Two (2) courses in Visual Studies / Art History (in addition to those satisfying VISST-104, -108, and -200).
