What is your major influence at the moment?

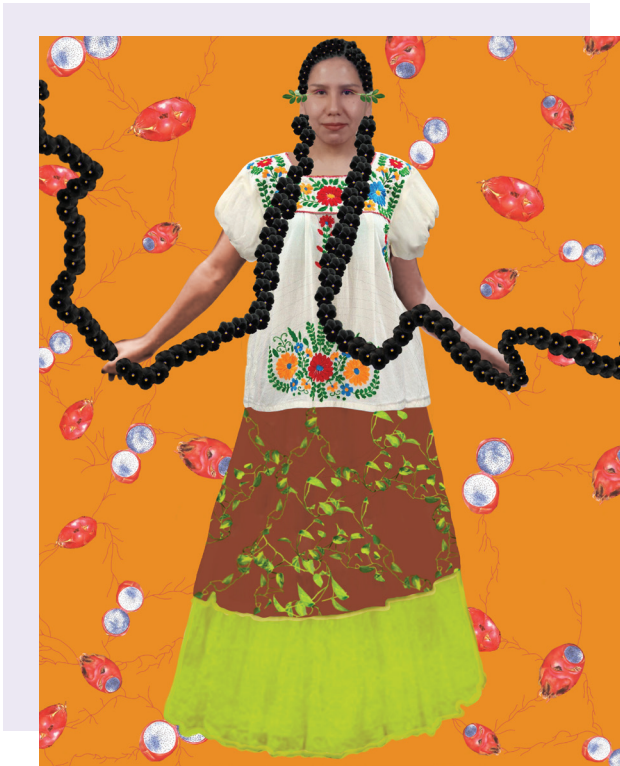
Influences in my process at the moment are the familial stories I have uncovered along the way, as well as music ranging from Ruben Blades to Residente.

Rupi Kaur has also been an influence. This poem has accompanied my making the last two years and I hold it close to keep me centered.

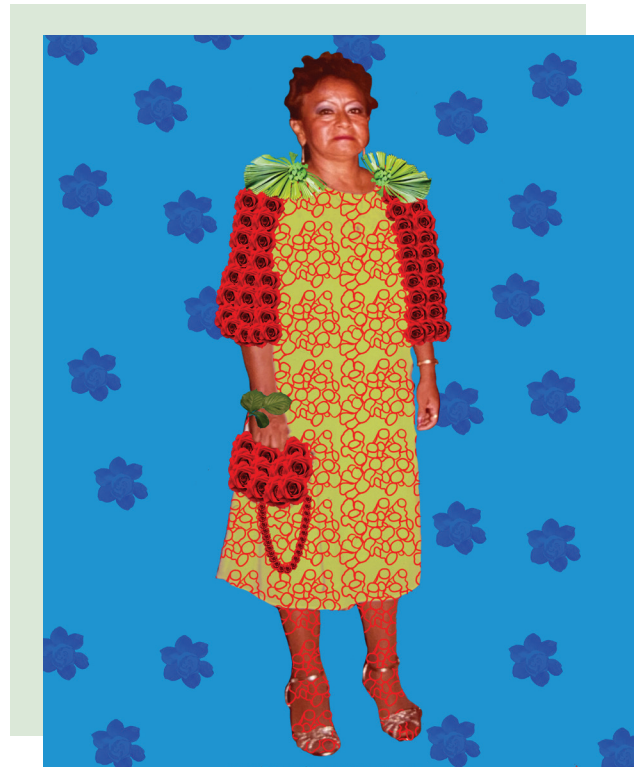
So how dare you mock your mother
